PBH employees are provided with a steady flow of patient referrals, stimulating weekly case consultation with supportive colleagues, continuing education stipend, mentorship, and highly competitive compensation including healthcare and retirement benefits for eligible employees.

PBH seeks to hire a clinician with expertise in treating eating disorders, in both adults and children/adolescents/families (interest or experience with FBT a plus). PBH treats a broad range of psychological conditions and houses specialty sub-clinics with distinct consultation teams, including trauma (“StandTALL”; [standtallclinic.com](http://standtallclinic.com)), eating disorders, couples and families, and women’s wellness. Ideal candidates would have interest in joining the eating disorders subclinic (“Thrive”) and would possess expertise in evidence-informed individual and group treatment of eating disorders, (e.g. FBT for Eating Disorders, CBT, DBT, IPT and/or ACT).
